Dear Parent/Guardian,

During the recent legislative session, Assembly Bill (AB) 219 was passed. AB 219 requires schools that demonstrate low achievement for English language learners (ELL) to establish a corrective action plan (CAP) designed to improve student outcomes. Identification of schools was based upon the most recent annual report of the statewide system of accountability in English language arts and mathematics and have been rated in the lowest 30 percent of public schools in Nevada in the achievement of ELLs.

Cheyenne High School has been identified as subject to the AB 219 CAP requirement.

The Clark County School District (CCSD) Board of Trustees allows a parent/guardian of a child attending a high school adopting a CAP, the option of transferring your child to another high school within CCSD that is not subject to AB 219 and has available seats in Grades 9–12.

To support the transfer option, CCSD has Open Enrollment. Parents/guardians who are interested in the Open Enrollment process for the 2021-2022 school year and want to learn about available high school options may complete an application online on *It's Your Choice* at dzc.ccsd.net under the Open Enrollment link.

Estimados Padres/Tutores,

Durante la reciente sesión legislativa, se aprobó el proyecto de Ley (AB) 219. AB 219 requiere que las escuelas que demuestren un logro bajo para los estudiantes aprendientes del idioma inglés (ELL) establezcan un plan de acción correctiva (CAP) designado a mejorar los resultados del estudiante. La identificación de las escuelas se llevó a cabo a partir del informe anual más reciente del sistema estatal de responsabilidad en artes del idioma inglés y matemáticas y han sido calificadas en el 30 por ciento más bajo de las escuelas públicas de Nevada en el logro de los estudiantes aprendientes del idioma inglés (ELL).

La escuela secundaria Cheyenne High School ha sido identificada como sujeta al requisito CAP del proyecto de ley AB 219.

El consejo Directivo del Distrito Escolar del Condado de Clark (CCSD) permite a los padres/tutores de un niño que asiste a una escuela secundaria que esté adoptando CAP, la opción de trasladar a su hijo a otra escuela secundaria dentro del CCSD que no esté sujeta al proyecto de ley AB 219 y que tenga plazas disponibles del 9.º al 12.º grado.

Para apoyar la acción del traslado, CCSD tiene Inscripción Abierta. Los padres/tutores que estén interesados en el proceso de inscripción abierta para el año escolar 2021-2022 y que quieran saber más sobre opciones de escuelas secundarias disponibles pueden completar una solicitud en línea en It's Your Choice en:
